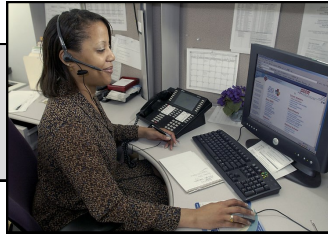

Job Training Eligibility Information



Worcester Building Pathways Pre-Apprenticeship

- 8 week training program designed to prepare participants for apprenticeship as commercial laborers, carpenters, etc.
- Women, minorities and veterans are encouraged to apply!
- Average starting wages for union apprentices are \$17/hr.!
- Classes are Mon. through Fri. 7am-3pm Feb. 5th – March 30th

Contact Center Training

- 3 week training program designed to prepare participants for entry level customer service positions in call centers for local banks, health insurance providers, cable providers, etc.
- Average starting wages in the industry are \$16/hr.!
- Classes are Mon. through Fri. 9am-12:30pm March 5th – 22nd

Commercial Driver's License Class B Training

- 3 week training program designed to prepare participants for the commercial driver's license Class B exam.
- Drivers needed for delivery, recycling and road maintenance!
- Average starting wages in the industry are \$17/hr.!
- Classes are Mon. through Fri. 8am-5pm March 26th – April 13th

Pharmacy Technician Pre-Apprenticeship

- A new training is being developed to prepare participants for entry level work as pharmacy technicians.
- The training is partnered with CVS's apprenticeship program!
- Average starting wages in the industry are \$13/hr.
- Classes are expected to begin during May 2018!

- Be 18+ years of age
- Have a Valid Driver's License
- Be authorized to work in the U.S.
- Complete Drug Testing

Preference given to applicants with a valid CDL permit!

Pharmacy Technician Pre-Apprenticeship

Applicants must:

- Live in Central Massachusetts
- Be Low to Moderate Income and receiving some government assistance (SNAP, Section 8, etc.)
- Be 18+ years of age
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Be authorized to work in the U.S.
- Complete Drug Testing

Preference given to applicants with healthcare experience!
